

## **Explosion, Aircraft Crash, etc.**

**In the event a violent accident, such as an earthquake, explosion or aircraft crash, occurs on campus that could render a building or area unsafe, take the following action:**

1. Immediately take cover under tables, desks or other objects for protection against glass or debris.
2. After effects of the explosion have subsided, notify Campus Safety and Security. Give your name; describe the location and nature of the emergency.
3. If necessary, or as directed to do so by Campus Safety and Security or college staff, activate the building evacuation alarm.
4. Notify your Supervisor or instructor, then evacuate the immediate danger area:
  - **Be aware of structural damage.**
  - **Stay away from glass doors and windows.**
  - **Do not touch or move any suspicious object.**
5. Assist others, especially the injured and persons with disabilities, in evacuating the building.
6. Once outside, move to a clear area at least 50 feet away from the affected building. Keep the walkways clear for emergency vehicles.
7. To the best of your ability, and without re-entering the building, assist Campus Safety and Security Officers or college staff in their attempt to determine that everyone has evacuated safely.
8. An Emergency Operations Center will be set up near the emergency site. Keep clear of the command post unless you have important information to report.
9. **DO NOT RETURN TO A BUILDING UNTIL TOLD TO DO SO OR UNTIL 'ALL CLEAR' HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED.**
